Homework Assignment #1

Due Thursday, January 22

This assignment is designed to get you acquainted with several of the UNIX utilities discussed in the introduction section of this course.

- 1. Create a small text file using the **vi** editor. The contents of this file are not important, but should be long enough to give you a chance to use several of the editing techniques discussed in class (i.e. a good paragraph or two).
- 2. Copy your file to a new file.
- 3. Display the contents of the new file to the screen using cat or more.
- 4. Rename a file in the current directory.
- 5. Provide a long listing of files in the current directory
- 6. Use grep to display the lines from the file you created containing "2009".
- 7. Display the last three lines of the file you created.
- 8. Sort the contents of the file you created.
- 9. Compress a file in the current directory.
- 10. Show an example using the command "ls" with an option not discussed in class
- 11. Display a list of users currently logged on your UNIX machine.

Note: Either use "script" to record your terminal session, or cut and paste your output into a text file.
